## TU DANCE COMMUNITY SAFETY STATEMENT

At TU Dance, <u>the priority is to keep everyone safe</u>. This statement serves as a guidance to all TU Dance Center visitors as it provides the safety procedures and rules for our facility, and must be followed at all times until further notice. We assume it's everyone's responsibility to make sure of its compliance.

- Please read the <u>TU Dance COVID-19 Preparedness Plan</u>, revised on August 31, 2021.
- Proof of COVID-19 complete vaccination (vaccination cards or other documentation) is required for employees, contractors, and renters entering TU Dance Center. This includes staff, teaching artists, accompanists, volunteers, renters and their crew/guests, visitors, etc. At this time, proof of vaccination is not required for enrolled students in the Pre-Professional and Children & Teen Programs. We encourage our community to get a COVID-19 Vaccine.
- A <u>universal mask mandate</u> is in place for all entering the facility.
- <u>6-feet social distancing</u> is to be practiced at all times while in the facility.
- <u>Hand washing and/or use of hand sanitizer</u> is required when entering the facility and as necessary during the visit.
- Sharing or exchange of food, beverages, educational materials, and any other items is to be avoided.
- <u>Teaching artists, accompanists and renters are required to disinfect surfaces after</u> <u>each class or rehearsal.</u>
- If someone is feeling sick, please go home immediately. Get tested and follow CDC guidance.
- If you have been exposed to COVID-19, stay home, get tested and follow the TU Dance COVID-19 Preparedness Plan and CDC guidance.
- <u>Communicating with TU Dance Center's staff</u> is essential if someone has contracted or has been exposed to COVID-19.
